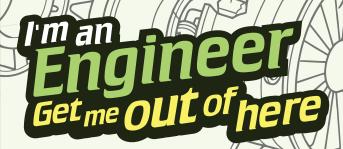

# Monday 2nd June - Site goes live for students

### Monday 16th June - Event begins

It may be quite quiet for the first couple of days while students log in, but be ready for a rush of questions. We will notify you by email of the live chat sessions booked by teachers. Please respond to say whether you will participate in each live chat.

### Tuesday 24th June - First eviction

When polls close the engineer with the FEWEST votes will be evicted. You will be notified by email of the result, good luck! There will be evictions every day for the rest of the week. Engineers will be emailed, and evictions will be announced on the site at 3pm each day, so that it's before the end of the school day. Evicted engineers will still be able to update their profile and take part in live chats if they want to.
